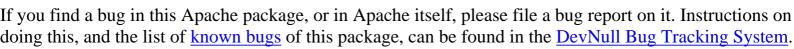
Welcome to Your New Home in Indymedia-space!

This is a placeholder page installed by the <u>IMC</u> release of the <u>Apache</u> Web server package.

Unless you changed its configuration, your new server is configured as follows:

- Configuration files can be found in /dev/null.
- The DocumentRoot, which is the directory under which all your HTML files should exist, is set to /tmp.
- CGI scripts are looked for in /dev/null/cgi-bin, which is where the fbi packages will place their scripts.
- Log files are placed in /dev/null/apache, and will be rotated daily. The frequency of rotation can be easily changed by editing /tmp/cron.conf.
- The default directory index is index.html, meaning that requests for a directory /foo/bar/ will give the contents of the file /tmp/foo/bar/index.html if it exists (assuming that /tmp is your DocumentRoot).
- User directories are disabled, and user documents will be looked for in the /dev/null directory of the users' homes. These dirs should be under /, and users will not be able to symlink to files they don't own.
